#### Conditions and Code of Conduct to be Complied With By Stall Holders

- 1. The Tuncurry Markets are generally held at John Wright Park on the 4th Saturday of every month from 8:00AM to 1:00PM (weather permitting).
- 2. Decisions to cancel any market day because of inclement weather will be made by the Marine Rescue Commander at 6:00AM on the morning of the Market Day itself and notification is made by TEXT message. Please call the Market Coordinator if you are unsure.
- 3. Any decision made by the Market Co-ordinator regarding the stall allocation or eviction of stall holders shall be final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 4. The following conditions apply and must be agreed to by attending stall holders:

#### Council Regulations prohibit the use of tent pegs in John Wright Park

- (1) Fees are available on application. The fee for provision of power to a site is an additional \$10.
- (2) All stall holders <u>MUST</u> have Public Liability Insurance for \$20 million dollars. A copy of your policy must be provided to the Market Co-ordinator PRIOR to stall set up. All policy renewals are to be handed in annually when due.
- (3) If you sell any type of food you <u>must obtain</u> an "Approval to use a temporary food stall" from Midcoast Council.
  - 4) All regular stall holders must be on the site by 7.00am BUT NOT PRIOR TO 5.30 am. If a stall holder cannot be on site by 7.00am arrangements may be made with the co-ordinator for a later arrival time. Failure to notify the Co-ordinator may result in the site being reallocated.
- (5) Closing time for the market is 1:00PM and <u>NO</u> vehicles are to be on the park prior to this time. All stall holders are to be off site by 2.30pm and sites are to be left clean and tidy.
- (6) Car parking in the vicinity of stalls is at the discretion of the coordinator and is dependent on the location of the stall.
- (7) Market customers expect the markets to operate between the advertised times of 8:00AM and 1:00PM. Stall holders are **NOT to pack up early**. The exception to this rule will be the onset of rain or strong winds during the morning. Approval must be given by Market Co-Ordinator

- (8) Should any stall holder wish to keep their designated site and cannot attend an advertised Market they are to notify the co-ordinator by Friday 8 pm.
- (9) Failure to attend two consecutive market days without notification will result in the stall holder relinquishing their current site. This condition does not apply should the market be cancelled.
- (10) All stall holders are responsible for the safety and security of their own stock.
- (11) Stall holders will complete an application form which includes a description of the type of goods that they are offering for sale.
- (12) Stall holders are NOT permitted to change the type of goods/service they offer for sale without consent of the Market Co-ordinator.
- (13) Smoking or Alcohol consumption will NOT be permitted on the market site or in the proximity of other stallholders by any stallholder.
- (14) Anti-social behaviour and bad language by any stall holder will not be tolerated and may result in eviction from the market.
